Glossary

These abbreviations and terms are used in our patterns.

<u>Crochet</u>

* * Repeat the instructions inside the asterisks the specified number of times.

- ch Chain
- dc Double crochet
- dec Decrease
- hdc Half double crochet
- rnd Round
- sl st Slip stitch
- sc Single crochet
- sc2tog Single crochet 2tog
- sp Space
- st Stitch
- sts Stitches
- X Times
- yo Yarn over

<u>Knitting</u>

* *	Repeat the instructions inside the asterisks the specified number of times.
Bind off	Securing the remaining stitches to finish your work
Cast on	Placing stitches on one needle to begin work
Garter St	itch Knit every row
Inc	Increase the number of stitches by one stitch
Κ	Knit
K2tog	Knit two stitches together. This decreases one stitch from your work
Knitwise	Carrying out the instructions as if to knit
Magic Lo	op A method for knitting in the round on a circular needle
_	(How to do Magic Loop Knitting: <u>click to watch the video</u>)
Pm	place marker
Psso	Slip a stitch from the left needle to the right needle, then knit a stitch and pass the slipped stitch over it. This decreases one stitch from your work.
Р	Purl
Purlwise	Carrying out the instructions as if to purl
Sl1	Slip 1 stitch from the left needle to the right needle
Sm	Slip marker to left needle
Stockine	tte Knit one row, purl one row
Tbl	Through back loop
