LOVELY LACY SCARF

Finished size: About 7" by 54". You can increase or decrease the length of the scarf by follow the pattern until the scarf is the desired length. You can increase the width of the scarf by casting on more stitches in multiples of 2.

Materials:

Needles: Size recommended on yarn package

Yarn: Soft, warm worsted weight yarn

Directions:

Cast on 37 stitches. Slip the first stitch of each row to form a lovely even edge. Knit 6 rows, starting each row with a Sl1.

Begin pattern:

Rows 1 and 2: Slip 1, K3, yarn over (yo) K2tog. *K1 yo K2tog* K4

Row 3: Sl1 Knit across row

Row 4: Sl1, K4, purl to last 5 sts, K5

Continue these 4 rows until scarf is the desired length.

Knit 6 rows, starting each row with a Sl1.

Finishing: Weave in all ends.
