FAST AND WARM ADULT HAT

NOTE: We provide hats locally and globally, in warm climates and cold. This gives you many yarn options -cotton, blends, acrylic and wool.

Directions are for knitting flat with two needles or in the round with double points or a circular needle. The hat can be knit in one or more colors.

General Guidelines Glossary of terms

For our current needs, please refer to our latest newsletter

Gauge: 3.5 to 4 stitches to 1 inch

Materials:

Needles: Size 10.5 or size needles to knit at gauge

Yarn: Soft, washable bulky weight

Tapestry or yarn needle

Directions for knitting with two needles:

Cast on 64 sts.

- 1. K1 P1 rib for 3 inches
- 2. Stockinette stitch (Knit one row, purl 1 row) for 5 inches more-total of 8" from cast on edge.
- 3. Begin decreases.

Row 1: *Knit 6, K2 tog* across row (56 sts)

Row 2 and all even numbered rows: Purl across

Row 3: *Knit 5, K2 tog* together across row (48 sts)

Row 5: *Knit 4, K2 tog* (40 sts)

Row 7: *Knit 3, Knit 2 tog* across row (32 sts)

Row 9: *Knit 2, Knit 2 tog* across row (24 sts)

Row 11: *Knit 1, Knit 2 tog* across row and leave an 18 inch tail (16 sts)

Row 13: *Knit 2 tog* across row (8 sts)

Finishing:

- 1. Leaving a very tong tail, cut yarn. Thread the tapestry or yarn needle, and draw through remaining sts, going around twice.
- 2. Turn the hat inside out and sew down the back seam. Weave in the ends. Turn up the ribbed section.

Directions for knitting in the round:

Cast on 64 sts. Join to knit in the round, be careful not to twist the stitches. Mark the beginning of the round.

- 1. K1 P1 rib for 3 inches
- 2. Knit for 5 inches more-total of 8" from cast on edge.
- 3. Begin decreases.

Round 1: *Knit 6, K2 tog* (56 sts)

Round 2 and all even numbered rounds: Knit

Round 3: *Knit 5, K2 tog* (48 sts)

Round 5: *Knit 4, K2 tog* (40 sts)

Round 7: *Knit 3, Knit 2 tog* across row (32 sts)

Round 9: *Knit 2, Knit 2 tog* across row (24 sts)

Round 11: *Knit 1, Knit 2 tog* across row and leave an 18 inch tail (16 sts)

Round 13: *Knit 2 tog* (8 sts)

Finishing:

- 1. Leaving a long tail, cut yarn. Thread the tapestry or yarn needle, and draw through remaining stitchess, going around twice.
- 2. Weave in the ends. Turn up the ribbed section.

Bless your completed project with a hug and your love. It will provide comfort, healing, and hope for the recipient.
