



Fun Scarf
(Pattern from Sue Brunner)

Yarn: Any **soft** medium weight yarn.

Needles: Size 8

Pattern:

Cast on 18 stitches. This should measure about 4” (the width we’ve been asked to provide for the children and teens we serve.)

For the pattern, every row will begin and end with K2.

Row 1: (K2) Knit across (K2)

Row 2: (K2) Knit across (K2)

Row 3: (K2) K1 P1 across (K2)

Row 4: (K2) K1 P1 across (K2)

Repeat rows 1 – 4 until scarf is about 54” long (the length we’ve been asked for.)
End with rows 1 and 2.

Cast off.
