



## **Odds 'N Ends Cap for Kids or Adults** (Pattern from Katie Funk Wiebe & Barbara Gingrich)

This pattern allows me to use up odds and ends of yarn that are not enough for a hat by themselves.

**Skill Level:** Moderate Beginner

**Size:** This design creates a hat that will fit different ages by folding up the bottom edge as much as desired.

**Yarn:** Four-ply worsted weight, one main color (MC) and two other colors.

**Needles:** Size 9

### **Pattern:**

Cast on 72 stitches, 68 for a smaller hat, or any multiple of four.

**Row 1:** [Knit 2, purl 2 ] to end of row.

**Row 2:** [Knit 2, purl 2] to end of row

Continue in this ribbing pattern for desired length, about 8 to 8 ½ inches for a child's hat and 10 ½ to 11 inches for adult size, adding stripes in two other colors as desired.

**Begin decreasing:** This method of decreasing keeps the ribbed pattern throughout. The decreasing rows should be the right side of the cap.

**Row 1:** (decreasing row) [k 2 tog, p 2] repeat to end of row

**Row 2:** [k 2, p 1] repeat to end of row

**Row 3:** (decreasing row) k 1 [p 1, k 2tog] repeat to last 2 stitches, p 2

**Row 4 :** [k 1, p 1] repeat to end of row

**Row 5:** (decreasing row) k 1 [k 2 tog] repeat to last stitch, k 1

**Row 6:** Purl

**Row :** (decreasing row) [k2 tog] to last stitch, k 1

Cut yarn, leaving a long tail (about 18 inches). With yarn needle, pull yarn through remaining stitches and fasten securely, then turn hat inside-out and stitch the seam. Add a tassel if desired.
