



Lovely Lacy Scarf
(Pattern provided by Sally Ann Marich)

Yarn: 200 yards worsted weight yarn

Needles: US #10

Note: Slip the first stitch of every row with yarn in front as if purling. This will create a lovely, even edge.

Cast on 28 stitches.

Knit 4 rows of garter stitch (knit every row.)

Pattern:

Row 1 – Slip 1, K3, yarn over (yo), K2tog *K1, yo, K2tog, repeat from * across, ending with K4.

Row 2 – Same as row 1.

Row 3 – Knit across.

Row 4 – Slip 1, K4, Purl across, Knit last 5 stitches.

Continue these 4 rows for pattern.

When you have reached desired length (approximately 54”) end with 4 rows of garter stitch. Bind off.
