



Crocheted Pineapple Pattern Peace Shawl

(Adapted by Beth Fallavollita from a Rhonda Semonis afghan pattern.)

Finished size: Approximately 16" X 52"
Yarn: Worsted weight yarn, approximately 16 ounces
(465 grams; 1,250 yards)
Crochet hook: Size I (5.50 mm)

PATTERN (Make 3 Strips):

ROW 1: Ch 8, join with slip st to form a ring. Ch 3 (counts as first dc, now & throughout), work (dc, ch 2, 2 dc, ch 1, 11 tr, ch 1, 2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in ring: 19 stitches.
(**Note:** Loop a short piece of yarn around any stitch to mark this row as **right** side.)

Row 2: Ch 2, turn; (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in first ch-2 sp, ch 1, skip next ch-1 sp, sc in next tr, (ch 3, skip next tr, sc in next tr) 5 times, ch 1, skip next ch-1 sp, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in last ch-2 sp: 5ch-3sp.

Row 3: Ch 2, place marker around ch-2 to mark Preparation, turn; (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in first ch-2 sp, ch 2, skip next ch- 1 sp, sc in next ch- 3 sp, (ch 3, sc in next ch - 3 sp) 4 times, ch 2, skip next ch- 1 sp, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in last ch- 2 sp: 4 ch - 3 sps.

Row 4: Ch 2, place marker around ch- 2 to mark Joining, turn; (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in first ch- 2 sp, ch 2, skip next ch- 2 sp, sc in next ch- 3 sp, (ch 3, sc in next ch- 3 sp) 3 times, ch 2, skip next ch- 2 sp, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in last ch- 2 sp: 3 ch- 3 sps.

Row 5: Ch 2, turn; (2 dc, ch2, 2 dc) in first ch- 2 sp, ch 2, skip next ch- 2 sp, sc in next ch- 3 sp, (ch3, sc in next ch-3 sp) twice, ch 2, skip next ch- 2 sp, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in last ch-2 sp: 2 ch-3 sps.

Row 6: Ch 2, turn; (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in first ch- 2 sp, ch 3, skip next ch- 2 sp, (sc in next ch- 3 sp, ch 3) twice, skip next ch- 2 sp, (2 dc, ch 2, 2dc) in last ch- 2 sp: 3 ch- 3 sps.

Row 7: Ch 2, turn; (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in first ch- 2 sp, ch 3, skip next ch- 3 sp, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next ch- 3 sp, ch 3, skip next ch- 3 sp, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in last ch- 2 sp: 2 ch- 3 sps.

Row 8: Ch 2, turn; (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in first ch- 2 sp, ch 1, skip next ch- 3 sp, 11 tr in next ch- 2 sp, ch 1, skip next ch- 3 sp, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in last ch- 2 sp: 19 sts.

Row 9: Ch 2, turn; (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in first ch- 2 sp, ch 1, skip next ch- 1 sp, sc in next tr, (ch 3, skip next tr, sc in next tr) 5 times, ch 1, skip next ch- 1 sp, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in last ch -2 sp: 5 ch- 3 sps.

Row 10: Ch 2, turn; (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in first ch-2 sp, ch 2, skip next ch- 1 sp, sc in next ch- 3 sp, (ch 3, sc in next ch- 3 sp) 4 times, ch 2, skip next ch- 1 sp, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in last ch- 2 sp: 4 ch- 3 sps.

Row 11: Ch 2, turn; (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in first ch- 2 sp, ch 2, skip next ch- 2 sp, sc in next ch- 3 sp, (ch 3, sc in next ch- 3 sp) 3 times, ch 2, skip next ch- 2sp, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in last ch- 2 sp: 3 ch- 3 sps.

Rows 12 – 98: Repeat Rows 5 – 11, 12 times; then repeat Rows 5 – 7 one more time.

Row 99: Ch 2, turn; (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in first ch- 2 sp, ch 3, skip next ch- 3 sp, dc in next ch- 2 sp, ch 3, skip next ch- 3 sp, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in last ch- 2 sp: 2 ch- 3 sps.

Row 100: Ch 2, turn; (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in first ch- 2 sp, ch 2, skip next ch- 3 sp, sc in next dc, ch 2, skip next ch- 3 sp, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in last ch- 2 sp.

Row 101: Ch 2, turn; slip st in first ch- 2 sp, ch 2, skip next 2 ch- 2 sps, slip st in last ch- 2 sp; finish.

ASSEMBLY:

Preparation: With **right** side of first Strip facing you, and working in end of rows, join yarn with slip st in marked sp along right edge of Strip; ch 1, sc in same sp, * ch 5, skip next row, sc in ch- 2 sp on next row; repeat from * 45 times more; finish off. Repeat for second strip; leave third strip unworked to be joined first.

Joining: With **wrong** side of **first Strip** facing you, and working in end of rows, join yarn with slip st in marked sp on right edge; ch 1, sc in same sp, ch 2, having **second Strip** adjacent with **wrong** side facing, slip st in first ch- 5 sp on **second Strip**, ch 2, skip next row on **first Strip**, sc in ch- 2 sp on next row, * ch 2, slip st in next ch- 5 sp on **second Strip**, ch 2, skip next row on **first Strip**, sc in ch- 2 sp on next row; repeat from * 44 times more; finish off. Join third Strip in same manner.

Optional: Add tassels, bells, and beads.
