FUN SCARF

Finished size: About 7” by 54”. You can increase the length of the scarf by continuing to follow the pattern until the scarf is the desired length. You can increase the width of the scarf by casting on more stitches in multiples of 2.

Materials:

Needles: Size recommended on the yarn label
Yarn: soft, warm worsted weight yarn
Yarn or tapestry needle

Directions:

Cast on 36 stitches
Rows 1 and 2: Knit
Rows 3 and 4: K3, K1, P1 to last 3 stitches, K3
When scarf is the desired length, bind off loosely.

Finishing:

Weave in the ends.

Bless your completed project with a hug and your love. It will provide comfort, healing, and hope for the recipient.
