General Guidelines

Please carefully read the following before you start your project.

Each pattern has a difficulty rating in the upper left hand corner.



Choose a yarn that will produce an attractive and comfortable item that you would be happy to wear or give to a family member or friend.

Make sure your project is complete, including checking for dropped stitches and weaving in all ends.

Pay careful attention to the recommended finished sizes of items. These reflect consultation with our recipient agencies as well as shipping concerns.

All our on-line patterns include the element of three. If you are using your own pattern, please be sure it includes some element of three, such as a multiple of three stitches, a three-row pattern, three colors, three sections, etc. ([Elements of 3](#))

When you work on your project, please think of yourself-the crafter, the recipient and the spirit that connects us all. Infusing your project with intention adds to its value to both the recipient and the creator.

If you are using embellishments such as beads, buttons, or charms, please be sure they are **VERY** securely fastened.
