



Broomstick Lace Scarf

(Pattern from Reba Quastler and the San Diego Peace Pod)

Yarn: 1 skein Red Heart “Unforgettable” or Lion Brand “Mosaic”

Needles: Size 8 *and* either Size 17 or 19

Pattern:

Using size 8 needles, cast on 27 stitches.

Rows 1 & 2: Knit using size 8 needles.

Row 3: Change to larger needle for this row only and knit across.
(Hint: insert the needle point (but not the shaft) into the stitch, wrap yarn around, and draw the new stitch all the way onto the needle shaft.)

Row 4: Change back to size 8 needles and work all of the following stitches very loosely:

Knit 1st stitch.

Gathering Stitch: Knit 5 stitches together all at once,
Pull yarn forward but do not take off left needle.

YO – Yarn Over right needle

Repeat the Gathering Stitch (5 stitches together, as above)

YO – Yarn Over right needle

Repeat with each group of 5 stitches, ending with 1 single.

Repeat these 4 rows (above) until scarf is desired length.

Bind off. Add fringe if desired.
