



**Fun Scarf**  
(Pattern from Sue Brunner)

**Yarn:** Any **soft** medium weight yarn.

**Needles:** Size 8

**Pattern:**

Cast on 18 stitches. This incorporates an element of “3” in your scarf (every thing we make incorporates an element of 3 – if you don’t know why, check the Home Page of our website at [www.knitting4peace.org](http://www.knitting4peace.org)) Your scarf should measure about 4” wide by 54” long (the width we’ve been asked to provide for the children and teens we serve.)

For the pattern, every row will begin and end with K2.

Row 1: (K2) Knit across (K2)

Row 2: (K2) Knit across (K2)

Row 3: (K2) K1 P1 across (K2)

Row 4: (K2) K1 P1 across (K2)

Repeat rows 1 – 4 until scarf is about 54” long (the length we’ve been asked for.)

End with rows 1 and 2.

Cast off.
