



Fur Stitch Crochet Scarf

(Pattern from Darlene Danyo, Highlands Ranch CO Peace Pod)

Completed scarf should measure approximately 4” wide and 50-54” long, the size requested by the majority of those we serve. For a complete list of our local and global deliveries, visit the Deliveries page on our website:

Yarn: Your choice, preferably soft to the touch

Hook: Size specified on yarn wrapper

Make a chain of desired length.

Row 1: DC in fourth ch from hook, then dc in each ch of chain. ch 1, turn

Row 2: Sc in front strand only (not in both top strands as usual) of the first dc below, *ch 5, sc in front strand (also called loop) of next dc*. Repeat from * to * across ending with last sc in top of ch-3. Ch 3 (counts as first dc of Row 3) Turn.

Row 3. Folding Row 2 back out of the way, skip ch-3 below first sc, then work a dc in the unworked top strand(loop) of each remaining stitch of Row 1. Ch-1, turn.

Repeat rows 2 and 3 for fur stitch pattern, working number of rows to achieve desired length. Fasten off.

The front side will have loops, the back side will be smooth when it is completed.
