



Peace Shawl for All Reasons

(Adapted by Carol Loughner, Henrietta Peace Pod, from a pattern in Knitting Along With Debbie Macomber Friendship Shawls, page 6)

Skill level: Easy
Finished size: Approximately 20 1/2 "wide x 72" long
Yarn: Any soft, hand-washable bulky weight (3.52 oz., 124 yards):
5 skeins
Needles: 10 1/2 or size needed for gauge.
Gauge: In pattern, 10 stitches = 3 3/4 "
(Cast on 10 sts. Row 1: K3, P3. Row 2: Purl across.
Repeat rows 1 & 2 for 4". Bind off all sts in purl.
Measure to check gauge. Adjust needle size as needed.)

SHAWL:

Cast on 57 stitches. (For a wider shawl, cast on 63, 69, or 75 stitches.) The number of stitches is divisible by 3, the iconic element incorporated in each item created by K4P. For an explanation please refer to our Mission on the Home page of our website: www.knitting4peace.org.)

Rows 1 – 6: Purl across.

Pattern is created by Rows 7 & 8. Repeat these two rows until the shawl measures approximately 70 1/2" from the cast on edge, ending with Row 7:

Row 7 (right side): P3, (K3, P3) across.

Row 8: Purl across.

Final 6 rows: Purl across.

Bind off all sts in purl.

Say a prayer for the woman who will receive your Peace Shawl.
